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**KINGS ROAD BRIDGE BID**

The Kings Road Bridge Bids were open on June 19, 2008. The bid was separated into two bids. One bid for the Beam & Pile repairs and one bid for the Bulkhead Wall Replacement.

The Bulkhead Wall Replacement Bid had 2 bidders:

In the bid packets certain items were required to be with the bids. Cline Construction met the items they were required to have in their bid packet. Worth Contracting was missing their work plan and their material procurement plan. Without these items in their bid Worth Contracting did not have a responsive bid. Therefore Cline Construction is the only responsible bidder.

The Beam and Pile Repairs Bid had four bidders:

The low bidder, Worth Contracting, did not have in their bid submittal the following required items: proof of more than 3 years in business, a work plan, and a material procurement plan. Therefore their bid was not responsible. The second lowest bid by Sieg & Ambactsheer did not have in their bid packet the required AIA Form 305. Therefore, their bid was not responsive to the requirements of the bid. The third lowest bid submitted by Cline Construction met all the bid requirements. The fourth low bid, Fibrwrap Construction had all of the requirements of the bid. Therefore Cline Construction is the low Bid that met the requirements for the bid packet.

The results of the bids were reviewed by our engineers for the project and Mr. White, the City Attorney, was consulted to determine which bidder should receive the award. In both of the Bids, Cline Construction lowest bidder meeting the requirement call for in the bid. Cline's bid is as follows:
