ORDINANCE NO. 2009-02

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF NEPTUNE BEACH, FLORIDA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009, BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2008 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2009.

WHEREAS, the City of Neptune Beach adopted an operating budget for fiscal year 2009, and

WHEREAS, the nature of budgetary systems and those day to day decisions affecting such budgetary systems requires adjustments from time to time.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF NEPTUNE BEACH, FLORIDA, that:

1. The Fiscal Year 2009 Final Budget be Amended as follows:

Description:

The above revenues were the result of additional funding from FEMA for pickup of debris as a result of Tropical Storm Fay.

The additional expenditures will be allocated to the contingency fund for donations if the funds are received for reimbursement for Tropical Storm Fay. The donations to be made are as follows: Beaches Resource Center \$2,500, Beaches Trolley Service \$2,500 and Dial-A-Ride \$1,500.

Section 2. The Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the City Council.
