



## RESOLUTION NO. 2009-06

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEPTUNE BEACH, FLORIDA REQUESTING THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE A TAX COLLECTOR OFFICE AT THE BEACHES

**Whereas**, the city of Neptune Beach would like the Duval Tax Collector to maintain an office at the beach; and

**Whereas**, the office now located at 1505 Atlantic Boulevard opened in December 2007; and

**Whereas**, it services 15% of Jacksonville's population, Jacksonville Beach, Neptune Beach, Atlantic Beach, Mayport and the West Beaches; and

**Whereas**, there are over 180,000 residents in its service area; and

**Whereas**, it completed 82,580 transactions last year; and

**Whereas**, it has twelve employees; and

**Whereas**, the Mayport Naval Base has a large influx of military personnel who use the Tax Collector Office; and

**Whereas**, it offers the following services: Titles and Registrations; Renewals for Local Business Taxes; Current and Delinquent Property Tax Payments; Bus Passes for Jacksonville Transportation Authority; issue City of Jacksonville Animal Licenses; Process Payments for Parking Citations; Express Driver License Transactions; Storm Water Payments; all other miscellaneous City of Jacksonville invoices.

**Now, Therefore**, be it respectively requested by the City Council of Neptune Beach, Florida that the City of Jacksonville continue to provide to the Beaches a Tax Collector office at the Beaches so that our citizens do not have to travel into town for county services.

The Resolution shall become effective on after passage by the City Council.

This Resolution adopted by the City Council of Neptune Beach, Florida, at the Special Council Meeting held this 20<sup>TH</sup> day of April, 2009.
