A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEPTUNE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING ARTICLE III. ADMINISTRATIVE AND ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES, SECTION 27-163 EXPIRATION OF SPECIAL EXCEPTION PERMIT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Neptune Beach has determined that it is necessary to amend the following.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF NEPTUNE BEACH, FLORIDA, that:

Section 27. Sec. 27-163 Expiration of Special Exception Permit, shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 27-163. Expiration of Special Exception Permit. Unless the use or construction, specially permitted by the special exception, has actually been commenced within twelve (12) months following the date the special exception is rendered, the special exception shall expire and be of no further force, validity, or effect.
