BOARD OF APPEALS

(meetings on the third Wednesday of the month at 7pm)

This board is established to hear administrative appeals and applications for variances in the following zoning districts: R-1, R-2, R-3, R-4, and R-5.

PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT REVIEW BOARD

(meetings on the third Tuesday of the month at 7pm)

The planning and development review board is designated as the local planning agency. As such, the board is created to carry out the functions of a local planning agency pursuant to the requirements of Florida Statutes, Chapter 163, and to review and recommend action to the city council on (i) on special exceptions and land use policies; (ii) preliminary development plans; and (iii) variance requests for property located within the C-1, C-2, C-3, conservation and CBD zoning districts submitted under the provisions of the Code.

CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD

(meetings on the second Wednesday of the month at 7pm)

It is an administrative board with authority to impose administrative fines and other non criminal penalties to provide an equitable, expeditious, effective and inexpensive method of enforcing codes and ordinances in force in the city, where a pending or repeated violation exists or continues to exist.

POLICE OFFICERS RETIREMENT BOARD

(quarterly meetings on the third Thursday of the month)

The board is designated as the plan administrator. The sole and exclusive administration of and responsibility for the proper operation of the police retirement system

CIVIL SERVICE BOARD (meet as needed)

The board recognizes the resolution setting forth the personnel manual adopted by the City Council and services as a board of appeals for an aggrieved employee in determining compliance or failure to comply with the provisions thereof and other resolutions amending such polices adopted from time to tome

COMMITTEES

Committees are created by council as deemed necessary i.e. Beautification Arbor Day etc.
