ORDINANCE NO. 2017-29

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEPTUNE BEACH, FLORIDA AMENDING CHAPTER 2 ADMINISTRATION ARTICLE VI, FINANCE, BY AMENDING SECTION 2-364, SURPLUS PROPERTY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Neptune Beach, Florida has determined that it is in the best interest of the city to amend the Code as follows.

Now, Therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of Neptune Beach, Florida:

Section 1. Section 2-364, Surplus Property, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Neptune Beach is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2-364. Surplus property.

The city manager shall have the authority to declare property surplus and pursuant to the F.S. Ch. 274 sell, convey or dispose of surplus property the value of which does not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or is more than 10 years old. City council shall approve the disposal of any other surplus property.

Section 2. The Ordinance shall become effective after passage by the City Council.
