


# Building Permit Monthly Comparison


#### **Incoming Building Permit Fees**




### **Building Permit Incoming Fees**



#### Fire/Floodplain Incoming Fees





### Fire Permit Incoming Fees




## Code Enforcement Monthly Comparison

April had an increase above March for the number of permits reviewed and issued.




\*\*October monthly totals are always higher than the average because of fiscal year billing for Annual Fire Inspections.




