Incumbent ensures all laws and ordinances are enforced in an efficient, effective and professional manner. Work is performed under general supervision and performance is reviewed through conferences, reports submitted, and results obtained. Incumbent will enforce all city and state codes, ordinances, laws, and regulations in order to protect life and property and to prevent crime and promote security; apprehends and/or arrests persons who violate federal, state or City codes and laws and advises suspects of rights; processes and transports prisoners according to procedure.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimum age of 21 years;
- Must be a citizen of the United States;
- Minimum education of a high school diploma or equivalent, some college is preferred;
- Must not have been convicted of any felony; must not have been convicted of a misdemeanor involving perjury or a false statement;
- Must not have received a dishonorable discharge from any armed forces of the United States.
- Must not, AFTER July 1, 1981, plead guilty, no contest, have been found guilty of any felony or of
 a misdemeanor involving perjury or false statement, notwithstanding suspension of sentence or
 withholding of adjudication;
- Must have completed the Florida Basic Recruit class <u>and passed the FDLE certification</u> examination (currently enrolled students may apply);
- Must have a current, valid Florida Driver License;
- Must have good moral character as determined by a background investigation, which includes a drug screen and Computer Voice Stress Analysis, if applicable;
- Must pass a physical and psychological examination by licensed physicians based on specifications established by the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission.
